## The Malvern Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty

The Malvern Hills and surrounds were designated an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) in 1959. The AONB designation signifies that the natural beauty of the area – including its landscape, wildlife, geology and archaeology – is of national importance and that it is in the nation's interest to look after it. The Malvern Hills is one of 40 AONBs in England and Wales.

The Hills Hopper bus service and the information on other bus services described in this brochure is aimed at helping visitors and residents to get around the area. Buses provide a great vantage point from which to enjoy the wonderful scenery of the AONB. Leaving your car at home and making use of local bus services means that you will also be helping to protect the peace and tranquillity of the area which is under threat from the increasing number of cars. In order to help you enjoy the area the Hills Hopper has been designed to carry bicycles. This brochure also contains information on short walks that you can do from the route of the Hills Hopper itself.

### Visiting the Malvern Hills from further afield?

The Hills Hopper and the 476 bus services both stop at Great Malvern and Ledbury train stations. The 675 bus service connects the AONB with Ledbury train station.

If you are thinking of visiting the area why not travel in by train and connect to these local bus services? For example, the 09.30 train from Birmingham Snow Hill (10.29 from Worcester Foregate St) on a Sunday arrives at Great Malvern at 10.41, in time to meet the Hills Hopper.

A number of other buses also serve the area from further afield, for example, the 44B (operated by First bus company) travels to the Malvern Hills area from Worcester on each Sunday and Bank Holiday Monday throughout 2008.

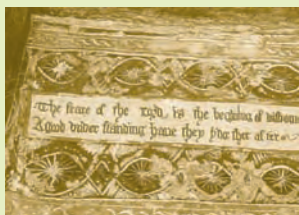
